#### Level 1 (Grades 3-5)

- 1. *Simple Tops* (shirt, tank top, t-shirt, vest, poncho, costume, or any other similar simple top). No lined garments. Exhibits in classes 01 and 02 are to be SIMPLE. Exhibit must have two (2) or more of the specific skills/techniques listed under any of the following headings Level 1 Mastery Sheet: Buttons, Casing, Hem, Seams, Seam Finishes.
- 2. *Simple Bottoms* (shorts, capris, pants, skirts, costume, or any other similar simple bottom). Garments are not to be lined, have pockets or a zipper. Exhibits in classes 01 and 02 are to be SIMPLE. Exhibit must have two (2) or more of the specific skills/techniques listed under any of the following headings Level 1 Mastery Sheet: Hem, Seams, Seam Finishes, Waistband.
- 3. *Simple Lined or Unlined One-piece* garment with one or one or more: pocket, waistband or facing (top, bottom, robe, jacket, dress, jumpsuit, vest, poncho/shawl costume, or any other similar one-piece garment). Exhibit must have two (2) or more of the specific skills/techniques listed under any of the following headings in the Level 1 or 2 Mastery Sheet: Facing, Pocket, Waistband, Zipper, Interfacing, Seam Finish. Waistband can be a flat front band and elastic back.

#### Level 2 (Grades 6-8)

- 8. *Blouse/Shirt with sleeves and closure*. Exhibit must have two (2) or more of the specific skills/techniques listed under any of the following headings in the Level 3 Mastery Sheet: Buttons and Buttonhole, Fasteners, Sleeves, Zipper. No jackets, coats, or vests.

  9. *Lined or Unlined Bottom with zipper and pocket(s)* Exhibit must have two (2) or more of the specific skills/techniques
- 9. *Lined or Unlined Bottom with zipper and pocket(s)* Exhibit must have two (2) or more of the specific skills/technique listed under any of the following headings in the Level 3 Mastery Sheet: Interfacing/Underlining, Lining, Pockets, Zippers. Pocket style must be one described on the skill sheet.
- 10. *Lined or Unlined Two-piece garment* (coordinating top and bottom, jacket/vest with bottom/dress, PJ's, uniform, costume, or any other similar two-piece coordinate). Exhibit must have two (2) or more of the specific skills/techniques listed under any of the following headings in the Level 3 Mastery Sheet: Buttons and Buttonhole, Fasteners, Interfacing/Underlining, Lining, Pockets, Sleeves, Zipper.

#### Level 3 (Grades 9-12)

- 14. *One-piece lined or unlined garment* (pants, skirt, coat, jacket, dress, jumpsuit, uniform, formalwear, costume, or any other similar garment) with two (2) or more of the specific skills/techniques listed under any of the following headings in the Level 4 Mastery Sheet: Collar/Cuff, Buttons and Buttonholes, Fasteners, Hem, Interfacing/Under lining/Interlining, Lining, Seam, Seam/Finish, Zipper.
- 15. *Two-piece lined or unlined ensemble/coordinate* (coat/jacket/vest/shirt/blouse with dress/pants/slacks/skirt/etc., suit, costume, or any other similar two-piece coordinate with two (2) or more of the specific skills/techniques listed under any of the following headings in the Level 4 Mastery Sheet: Collar/Cuff, Buttons and Buttonholes, Fasteners, Hem, Interfacing/Under lining/Interlining, Lining, Seam, Seam/Finish, Zipper.
- 17. *Fashion Garment* created by Knitting/Crocheting/Tatting/Felting or similar technique. Knitted or crocheted exhibit must have two (2) or more of the specific skills/techniques listed under any of the following headings in the Level 4 Mastery Sheet: Crochet and/or Knitting.

#### **IMPRESSIVE DRESS**

This will be a fun and creative challenge that will enhance our members public speaking skills as well as learning about appropriate dress for every occasion. Buying new clothes for this contest is highly discouraged. Participants will introduce themselves and tell what 4-H club they belong to and give a brief description of their outfit that explains the following: why they chose their outfit, why it fits the category, where they might wear it and what their favorite part of the outfit is and why.

Beginner: 3rd-7th Grades Advanced: 8th-12th Grades CLOVERBUDS may model one outfit of their choice and introduce themselves. Cloverbuds will not be judged competitively. They will each receive a Participation ribbon.

**SNAPPY CASUAL:** Everyday nice outfit coordinated for a specific event (*school*, *social*, *etc*) (*Jeans without* holes, slacks, appropriate length shorts, skirts, dresses, coordinated separates, shirts with a collar, blouse or a t-shirt with appropriate slogans (4-H); Casual shoes, nice tennis shoes, or boots.)

**DRESS CLOTHES:** Outfits designed for professional business or dressy occasions (suit jacket, tie, slacks, dress, etc) (No denim) (Outfits cannot be considered Formal Wear).

**FRUGAL FASHION:** The purpose for this project/product is for youth to demonstrate their ability to be a thrifty consumer. Assemble a complete ensemble from items purchased at a thrift/consignment store/garage sale and/or similar source. Only clothes that are visible (does not include undergarments) and accessories are to be included in the finished ensemble. Shoes can be included but are not required. The participant is to model the complete outfit.

Include a Frugal Fashion Report which is a brief, written report including itemized price list and where each item was purchased or acquired. List any repairs or special attention that was needed to make use of the thrift *items* (belt polished, button sewn on, starched jeans, etc.). List the total cost of the ensemble.

# 4-H Ambassador program provides leadership opportunities

Since 1994, the Oklahoma 4-H Ambassador program has provided club members additional opportunities to hone their leadership skills. Hundreds of 4-H youth have benefitted from the opportunities afforded them through this program.

Applications will soon be available to 4-H'ers who are interested in learning more about leadership, as well as promoting the 4-H program across the state, said Cathy Allen, 4-H curriculum coordinator at the state 4-H office at Oklahoma State University. *The State 4-H Ambassador application deadline is March 15.* Hard copies of applications must be postmarked by March 15. Electronic applications must be submitted by 11:59 p.m. on that day. Interested applicants must be 13 years old by the application date and have at least one year of high school remaining.

Based on application scores, the top applicants will advance to the interview selection day slated on May 3. The three-part interview process includes an extemporaneous speech, a face-to-face interview, and a writing assignment.

Your help in getting information out is appreciated but it does not need to be your responsibility to coordinate entries for your county.

#### **ENTRY INFORMATION:**

Members may only participate in either the prerecorded video contest or the in-person contest, but not both. Youth are limited to one (1) presentation.

Due to the rising costs of awards: A \$5 registration fee per participant in both the prerecorded video and the in-person contest is requested mailed to Pontotoc County 4-H, 1700 N. Broadway, Ada, OK 74820. Please note the participants' name(s) along with the registration fee. No refunds. Self/family entries are PREFERRED over Extension Office's entering youth.
