

Did You Know? In 1908 W. D. Bentley, a pioneer of university extension work in Oklahoma, set up headquarters in Tishomingo to help fledgling ranchers and farmers improve harvests. The 4-H idea in Oklahoma took root when Bentley enrolled fifty boys from across Johnston County to be part of a Boy's Corn Club in 1909. The Smith-Lever Act (1914) authorized the federal government to help fund university extension work as well as the youth clubs. Enrollment skyrocketed, growing from those first fifty members in 1909 to almost twelve thousand in Oklahoma by 1915

4-H FUN at the FAIRGROUNDS MONDAY October 23rd

You are invited to 4-H Fun at the Fairgrounds on October 23 from 6 to 8pm. While the two Contests are being judged, Fun Activities are planned for 4-H Families in the meantime. Skill-athons, games, a parent break-out session, and more will happen from 6-8pm. A light hot supper will be served. As a county-wide community Veterans' service project, please bring gently used **paperback books** (no romance books).



<u>4-H FOOD SHOW</u> The Food Show is a county contest that gives 4-H members a chance to demonstrate their knowledge and skills related to food and nutrition. All entries are due by 5:55 pm October 23 in the **Kitchen of the Fair Building.**

Food Exhibits are to be made from scratch; no box mixes allowed Except for decorated categories. **Please provide recipes.** Food items should be on a paper plate or sturdy base in a plastic bag when possible. Contestant's Name needs to be on the bottom of the plate.

1st, 2nd, and 3rd place ribbons and premiums will be given in each class. The Sweepstakes Award is given in each of the following divisions: Junior, Intermediate, and Senior. Sweepstakes is determined by points earned from items entered. The prize money for this contest is donated by Beaver County OHCE.

Home canned food entries to be presented in standard jars made for home canning, with a raised pattern or lettering, clear, uncolored glass and two-piece lids. Jar rings should be left on for display.

*Poster Category: Educational poster based on food or kitchen safety. Entry counts in the sweepstakes tabulations. Posters must be new for this contest, dated in permanent marker on the back. These posters must **not** have been entered in the fair or previous contests. Each poster will receive a ribbon but no premium money in the food show.

<u>JUNIOR</u> (3rd (8 yrs. old*), 4th & 5th) of *Sept 1, 2023)

Participants may enter any or all of the following classes:

- Three Muffins
- Three Rolled Biscuits
- Three Baked Drop Cookies (no shaped cookies)
- One-pint or half-pint jar of jam or jelly
- Two pieces of fruit leather
- One -pint or half -pint of salsa/picante sauce
- A new, educational poster on food or kitchen safety*
- Decorated cupcakes (2 or more) Judged on decorations only.

INTERMEDIATE (6th-8th Grades as of Sept 1, 2023)

Participants may enter any or all of the following classes:

- * One-half loaf of any yeast bread (not a sweet dough) (made by hand or in a bread machine)
- * Three yeast cinnamon rolls (no icing)
- * Three rolled sugar-type cookies (no gingerbread)
- * One-pint jar cucumber pickles or vegetable relish
- * One- pint or quart of any single canned fruit
- * Dried Fruit (½ c of a single dried fruit) in plastic bag
- * A new, educational poster on protein food safety*
- * Decorated cupcakes (3 or more) Judged on decorations only.

SENIOR (9th-12th Grades as of Sept 1, 2023)

Participants may enter any or all of the following classes:

- ◆ One-half loaf or portion of breads from another culture. Include a one (1) page story on how this bread fits into that culture and its nutritional contribution
- → One-half of one 8" or 9" layer un-iced shorten type cake (no angel food or chiffon)
- → One (1) loaf Quick Bread, no yeast.
- → One (1) pint or quart jar pressure canned vegetables (no tomatoes or pickles)
- ◆ One (1) quart or one (1) pint jar of plain canned tomatoes
- ★ A new, educational poster based on outdoor cookery or grilling*
- → Specialty Shape Yeast Bread (Let your imagination go) Judged on decoration only.
- → Decorated Cake (at least 1 whole layer of cake) (Judged on Decoration only)

CLOVER BUD Division (5-8 years old) Not Judged

- 1. Drink Mix
- 2. Nutritional Snack (Not Cooked)
- 3. Decorated Cupcake or Cookie

The 4-H Demonstration Contest will be held on Monday, Nov. 6 starting at 6:00pm at the Beaver Co. Fairgrounds. All participants must be registered and ready to give their demonstration no later than 6:00pm. All participants are asked to preregister by **November 1st.**

Divisions as of September 1, 2023 are:

Junior—3rd (8 yrs old), 4th & 5th Grades;

Junior demonstrations must be 3-7 minutes.

Intermediate—6th-8th Grades; Senior—9th-12th Grades.

Intermediate and Senior demonstrations are 5-12 minutes.

A Video Category will be offered for participants not able to participate on Nov. 6th. Videos cannot be edited and must be received by the Extension by 1:00pm, November 3rd.

All demonstrations will receive a blue, red, or white ribbon. A Champion and Reserve Champion will be given for each age division.

Special Awards (may not be video presentation) are: Junior and Senior Breads, Dairy Presentation, Pork Promotion, Peanut Presentation, and/or Water Conservation. Call the Extension for information on specifications of these awards.
