COUNTY 4-H SPEECH CONTEST

Thursday, April 13, 2023

PRE-REGISTRATION IS REQUIRED (Your name and Title of Speech and Category) **WITH THE EXTENSION OFFICE BEFORE 5PM TUESDAY, APRIL 11, 2023.**

If you are unable to attend after you registered please let the office know.

Presentations will begin at 6 PM.

All contestants will need to be present no later than 6:30pm.

Divisions are by age as of September 1, 2022:

JUNIOR: 3rd (8 years old); 4th & 5th Grades;

INTERMEDIATE: 6th–8th; and **SENIOR:** 9th–12th Grades.

CATEGORIES:

Speeches—Illustrated or non-illustrated— A 4-H speech is one means of sharing information and educating an audience about a specific subject. It is an oral presentation in which the member may use posters/illustrations or objects to emphasize/illustrate specific points in the speech. A member does not actually make or demonstrate how to do something in an illustrated talk. No PPT presentations/slides in this division.

Time lengths for Speeches are: Junior—3 to 5 minutes, Intermediate and Senior—5-12 minutes.

PowerPoint Presentation—PPT slides replace posters and the presenter is demonstrating the skills they have mastered when integrating technology into a speech/presentation. Members will be evaluated on their ability to design and create the PPT slides which complement the oral content of the presentation. The PPT should not be the “presentation”. **Time lengths for PowerPoints are: Junior—3-5 minutes, Intermediate and Senior—5 to 7 minutes.**

Impromptu— Will draw a topic and will have a few minutes to prepare a speech on the topic provided.; for fun, no points or awards given.

Video Presentation—Videos are due to the Extension Office by Tuesday, **April 11, 2023, 5pm.** Videos should be submitted on a flash drive or contact the office for instructions for uploading to U-tube. The video must be a speech as though given in front of an audience without any editing, cropping, etc. **Time lengths for Video Presentation are: Junior— 3 to 5 minutes, Intermediate and Senior—5 to 7 minutes.**

2023 Beaver County 4-H Officers are requested to be in attendance to help with registration and awards.

STATE RECORD BOOK Deadline
