NOTICE:

To be eligible to show in the Blaine County Fair livestock divisions you must be an enrolled 4-H or FFA member in Blaine County. For all other exhibits, you must be a resident of Blaine County.

In order to be eligible for the 2024 Bonus Auction you must exhibit at least one animal, *or* enter two entries in 4-H or FFA divisions in the Foley Building, *or* participate in the tractor driving contest, *or* participate in the livestock judging contest.

Exhibits must be made, grown, or raised by the person exhibiting. If an article has been entered in a previous Blaine County Fair, it is not eligible to compete in the 2023 Blaine County Fair.

The Watonga Lion's Club will have a concession stand during the fair- come out and support them!
