Entry Requirements

- Enter the contest by selecting a team captain. That team captain will register the team when they enter the 4-H Contest Day.
- All participants must be active members of a club in Canadian County. Each club may have one Junior Team and one Senior Team. Cloverbuds are ineligible for this competition.
- Each member of the top three winning teams will receive individual points towards the all-around competition.

Contest Rules

- The contest will be administered according to the rules and regulations found at <u>Texas</u> <u>A&M University</u>.
 - Note the Canadian County 4-H contest will not offer a Beginner division. Beginner and Intermediate 4-H'ers will compete as Juniors or Seniors. Only Roundup-eligible members can move on to compete at Roundup. All other rules apply.

<u>Awards</u>

- 1. A Champion, Reserve Champion, and Bronze Champion Team will be named in the Junior competition and the Senior competition.
- 2. Following the competition, Roundup attendees will be invited to sign up for a spot on the team. If applicable, team members will be selected based on their position at the end of the competition.
- 3. All Around Points
 - a. 4-H'ers will earn all-around points as a Beginner, Intermediate, or Advanced contestant.
 - b. Entries who compete will be awarded 1 all-around point each.
 - c. Champion Team Members will each receive 5 all-around points.
 - d. Reserve Champion Team Members will each receive 4 all-around points.
 - e. Bronze Champion Team Members will each receive 3 all-around points.
