4-H JOB READINESS

Eligibility



Entry Requirements

- Enter the contest online before April 1, 2024, to be considered for the job.
- When you enter the contest, you will be given a URL to take you to the job application.
 When you start the job application, have your resume and cover letter completed, and your job selected. Once you begin the job application, you cannot leave. Final job applications close on April 10.
- 4-H members are responsible for completing the job application by the deadline. There will be no late applications allowed.
- If the 4-H member applies multiple times, the latest application will be the one used for the competition.

Objective

4-H members gain the life skills needed to be contributing members of our communities. One skill we strive to develop in 4-H'ers is Job Readiness. Job readiness is a set of skills and behaviors needed for any job you may be interested in. These are often referred to as soft skills, and include things like communication, problem-solving, teamwork, work ethic, and time management. The 4-H Job Readiness Contest allows 4-H members to practice these skills in the format of applying for a job.

Contest Details

In the Job Readiness Contest, you will apply for a job in the fictional business of Clover Industries. While the job is fictional, it is expected that you use your real-life credentials when filling out the application and creating your resume and cover letter.

Beginners

Judges will evaluate their cover letter, resume, and application. When the 4-H member arrives at the 4-H Contest Day, they will be assigned an interview position with their group. Judges will have already reviewed the Resume, Job Application, and Cover Letter. Interviews will last 5 minutes.

Beginner division participants may choose to apply for the Pet Sitter and the Cleaning Service positions.

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Intermediates

Judges will evaluate their cover letter, resume, and application. When the 4-H member arrives at the 4-H Contest Day, they will be assigned an interview position with their group. Judges will have already reviewed the Resume, Job Application, and Cover Letter. Interviews will last 10 minutes.

Intermediate division participants may choose to apply for a Pet Sitter, a Cleaning Service, a Restaurant Server, or a Kennel Assistant.

Seniors

Judges will evaluate their cover letter, resume, and application. When the 4-H member arrives at the 4-H Contest Day, they will be assigned an interview position with their group. Judges will have already reviewed the Resume, Job Application, and Cover Letter.

Interviews will last 15 minutes. After the interview, participants should write a thank you note provided by Canadian County 4-H. The purpose of the thank you note is to reinforce interest in the job, as well as thank the interviewers for their time and consideration.

Senior division participants may choose to apply for Restaurant Server, Kennel Assistant, Sales Associate, or Seasonal Agritourism Guide.

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Awards

- 1. According to the number of entries, the Top Placing Individuals (based on scores) will be recognized with top honors and will receive a personalized award (max 5 per division). All contestants will be judged on a Danish Scoring System.
- 2. All eligible entries will be invited to compete at the State 4-H Roundup.
- 3. All Around Points
 - a. Entries who compete will be awarded 1 All Around point each
 - b. Honors award recipients will receive 5 All Around Points
 - c. Blue Award earners will each receive 3 All Around Points
 - d. Red Award earners will each receive 2 All Around Points
 - e. White Award earners will each receive 1 All Around Points

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JOB₁

Pet Sitter - \$10 per animal per day

The Pet Sitter's responsibilities include cooking special meals for pets as instructed by pet owners, reporting behavioral issues to pet owners, as well as playing with pets to encourage mental and physical stimulation. You should also be able to vacuum pet hair and dander off carpets and furniture.

Basic Job Requirements:

- Read pet care information and understand pet-sitting duties.
- Providing pets with food and fresh water.
- Administering medication to pets according to the instructions provided by pet owners.
- Cleaning out litter boxes, cages, and aquariums, as well as changing rodents' beddings.
- Exercising pets as needed, which includes taking dogs out for regular walks.

Responsibilities may include, but are not limited to:

- Grooming pets as required, which includes bathing them, cleaning out their ears, brushing their teeth and coats, and trimming their nails.
- Providing regular updates to pet owners, which include communicating with them telephonically or via email as well as sending video clips and photos.
- Promptly notify pet owners of pet illnesses or injuries that may occur.
- Accompanying pets to the veterinary for check-ups or vaccinations.

JOB 2

Cleaning Service - \$10 per room

Basic Job Requirements:

- Bring in mail or newspaper
- Dust picture frames and lampshades
- Sweep, vacuum, and mop floors
- Shake out small rugs and mats
- Fold laundry
- Empty trash cans

Responsibilities may include, but are not limited to:

- Clean kitchens and bathrooms
- Change bed sheets
- Clean mirrors
- Mow the lawn
- Sweep garage, deck, or patio

- Issue bills and accept payment.

- Experience with animal care is preferred, but not required.

Responsibilities may include, but are not limited to:

- Assist in scheduling boarding appointments.
- Greet humans and pets with kindness and reassurance.
- Serve meals and clean kennels.
- Provide exercise for pets.
- Required to work at least one weekend day (Saturday and/or Sunday) per week.
