

# State 4-H Round-Up

Round-Up is a state conference for 4-H members 13 to 19 years of age. It includes special activities, programs, workshops, competitive events and election of state and district officers. It is held annually on the OSU Stillwater campus.

## Objectives

- To provide opportunities for youth to participate in leadership training that will help them develop a stronger 4-H program in the community, county, and state
- To involve youth in learning experiences that will afford specific skills and information in areas of interest, as well as in leadership and citizenship.
- To offer information about career opportunities and to stimulate interest in preparing for a career.
- To provide inspiration for promoting 4-H
- To recognize the achievement of 4-H members and direct public attention to the programs of 4-H.
- To offer opportunities for youth to make new friends, share experiences and establish individual goals.

## Who Can Participate

- Members must have reached his/her 13th birthday by January 1 of the year attending.
- Must be 13 years old by January 1 of the year attending.
- Approved by county Extension educator
- Must sign a code of conduct and a medical release form (RAM) and given to county Extension educators that are attending Roundup.
