

County 4-H Officers



County 4-H officers will be elected in September and installed at the county awards program in October. Contact your local club leader or the county extension office if you are interested in serving as a county 4-H officer.

Qualified 4-H members may run for a county office. Requirements for county officers are:

- Candidates filing for the offices of president, vice president, secretary, and reporter must be 14 years of age by January 1, 2022 and must have been a 4-H member for four years.
- Candidates filing for the offices of game or song leader must be 12 years of age by January 1, 2022 and must have been a 4-H member for two years.
- All candidates must have turned in a record book for the 2020-2021 year.
- If elected to a county 4-H office, responsibilities include:
 - Participate in county officer training
 - Carry out all the duties and responsibilities of the specific office
 - Attend and help with all county 4-H activities and events
 - Participate in as many county contests and activities as possible
 - Conduct self in a manner that will show pride and respect for the 4-H club, community, and county.
