6. Working at the Master Gardener booth at public events.
7. *Participating in public media (writing newspaper articles, being on radio or TV, filming and editing master gardener events).
8. *Participating in school programs, including contacting schools and follow-up.
9. Serving on committees for Master Gardeners.
10. Serving as officer or committee chair.
11. *Giving presentations as a Master Gardener.
