County Medal Applications 2023

What project area have you done work in this year? Have you received a project medal in all the areas? 4-H has to offer? If you have not received the information from your local meeting, applications for county awards are available at the Extension Office. You can apply for up to four medals and receive two. All medals will be presented at the 4-H Achievement Banquet in September. As a second incentive to complete your medal application, the Leaders Council will pay ½ the cost of 4-H camp for all members who successfully complete a medal application. That is a great reason to start working toward completing it today. All 4-H medal applications are due in the Extension Office by June 5th during Leaders Meeting.

June 1, 2023: Online Nomination Kits Order Opens *All nomination kits must be ordered and paid for online. When ordering, there will be an option to ship or pick up in Tulsa. Pickup is \$10.00 Shipped will be \$15.00 each.

June 22, 2023: Nomination Kit Shipment Deadline *All nomination kits ordered after June 24 will be required to be picked up in Tulsa.

July 1, 2023: Nomination Deadline for Market Steers, Barrows, Lambs, Goats, and Breeding Commercial Ewes, Gilts, Does, Commercial Heifer * All DNA must be post marked with a copy of the online nomination receipt. *Animal nomination must be submitted online, and DNA sample mailed with a copy of the online receipt. You do this yourself.

September 1, 2023: Contest Deadline

September 1, 2003: Livestock and Horse Show Late Entry

OSU Field Days

The OSU 2023 Animal Science Field Days will be held at the OSU Animal Science Totusek Arena July 18, 2023 - July 20, 2023. ONLINE Entries for the Tulsa State Fair

All entries for the Tulsa State Fair will have to be made online this year. <u>All entry verifications, exhibitor</u> waivers and entry fees must be postmarked no later

than August 25th. This is your responsibility to get taken care of. You can do the entries online.

The Tulsa State Fair Junior Livestock Shows are limited to Oklahoma 4-H members and/or Oklahoma FFA members. Youth who have a 4-H enrollment card on file in their respective County Extension Office on or before September 1, have reached their eighth birthday on or before September 1, 2023, AND are in the 3rd grade will be eligible to show at the Tulsa State Fair. Also, 4-H/FFA members that have neither graduated from high school before May 2023 nor reached their 19th birthday before January 1, of the year of the show will be eligible to show at the Tulsa State Fair. For animal species where nominations are required, the youth must follow the appropriate procedures and must declare organization affiliation at the time of nomination. Junior exhibitors must have certification of their qualifications if questioned as to age or club or chapter membership.
