

Noble County 4-H Good Standing/Eligibility

To be considered in good standing and eligible to participate under 4-H in contests outside of 4-H sponsored events, Noble County 4-H'ers need to:

- 1) have accepted enrollment in Noble County 4-H with dues paid
- 2) have completed the number approved 4-H events

The number of 4-H events required is staggered throughout the year, from needing to have enrollment completed and dues paid before the Free Fair, to having attended three (3) events prior to going to OYE or the Spring Judging Contests. There are a ton of options to fulfill the requirements, and more will be created all the time. At any time, I will help create opportunities for those that think they will be unable to fill requirements. All it takes is meeting me halfway with a phone call, email, or a visit to the Extension Office. If for any reason completing the three events is unachievable call/email the Extension Office before the competition.

Time specific requirements:

1) Noble County Free Fair

4-H'ers must be enrolled and have paid the enrollment fee

If the youth has entered as 4-H but not enrolled, I will be contacting the family. If calls and emails are ignored, the youth will not be allowed to check-in animals and will be sent to the Show Arena Office to complete enrollment.

2) Tulsa State Fair/ OK State Fair

4-H'ers must have at least one event completed

If the youth have not, we will come up with something (virtual presentation, quick community service project etc.)

3) Noble County Spring Junior Livestock Show

4-H'ers need to have two events completed

There are several options leading up to and during the Spring Show. The PVA would love help in the Concession Stand during the Spring Show AND the Art and Photography Contest is going on.

The three 'events' need to be completed before OYE/ Spring Judging Contests.

4-H Events that count:

- Attending Club Meetings
- Club Events (like working on floats or booths)
- Club Fundraisers

Persons with disabilities who require alternative means for communication or program information or reasonable accommodation need to contact the Noble County Extension Office at 580-336-4621 at least two weeks prior to the event.

- Club Community Service/civic engagement
- Club Workshops
- County 4-H Events (including the Free Fair 4-H Division)
- Attending County 4-H Youth Council Meetings
- County 4-H Workshops
- County 4-H Fundraisers
- County 4-H Community Service/civic engagement
- District 4-H Workshops
- District 4-H Events (like YIA or Discovery Unlimited)
- State 4-H Workshops
- State 4-H Events (like a showmanship clinic **sponsored by a 4-H club**)

Examples:

Suzie, shows cattle at Local, County and District

- (1) goes to the August Club Meeting
- (2) enters her Vet Science Poster in the Free Fair
- (3) helps clean the Concession Stand at the Spring Livestock Show

Chris, participates in Horticulture Judging

- (1) attends the 4-H Fun and Enrollment Day
- (2) participates in a virtual 4-H Dog Obedience Contest
- (3) helps maintain the Courthouse Flowerbed

Jeff, participates on the 4-H Archery Team

- (1) attends the Dish Garden Workshop
- (2) participates in Cupcake Wars
- (3) goes to the Trout Fishing Workshop at CCC

Sadie, shows market barrows at OYE and wants to enter the AFR Agricultural Achievement Contest in 2022

- (1) attends the August Club Meeting
- (2) attends the September Club Meeting
- (3) attends the October Club Meeting
