## MEDICATION SAFETY FOR SENIORS WORKSHOP

The Oklahoma County Oklahoma Home and Community Education (OHCE) organization hosted a Medication Safety for Seniors workshop for the public.

Ty Gregson, OSU Opioid & Substance Use
State Specialist, shared important
information regarding the issues with seniors
misusing their prescribed medications. Many
older Oklahomans forget to take their
medicine and then double the dose when
they take it the next time. Additionally, they
often share their unused medication with
friends and family, which is very dangerous
and illegal.

Mr. Gregson also discussed appropriate methods for disposing of unused medication, shared information about using Narcan for opioid overdoses, and where it can be obtained.

# Food Demonstration at NE Health & Wellness Center



She addressed the importance of heart health, underlining the significance of incorporating nutrient-rich foods into daily diets. She shared tips such as how to reduce sodium in the diet, which is often a concern for individuals with high blood pressure and other cardiovascular diseases. 




The Oklahoma County Master Gardeners volunteer program offered their annual gardening workshop series on three Saturdays in February.
