4-H Impressive Dress is designed for 4-H members to select fashionable garments, learn about care and storage of the outfit, and communication skills.

Divisions: The age and grade will be as of September 1 of the current 4-H year.

- Cloverbuds: ages 5-8, or Kindergarten-2nd
- Juniors: 3rd (and 8 yrs. old)-5th grade

- Intermediate: grades 6th-8th
- Senior: grades 9th-12th

Deadline: Sign up by 4:30 PM Friday February 18th.

Sign up: An entry form is on the extension.okstate.edu/Ottawa website, but you do not have to use the entry form to enter. Call the Extension office or Turn in form to your 4-H Leader or email completed form to <u>Jamie.foster@okstate.edu</u>. We will need the publicity release section of form completed by entry deadline.

Contest Guidelines:

- Cloverbuds (grades K-2nd) May have 1 entry and will receive a participation ribbon only.
- 3rd Graders: May enter Junior Division or as a Cloverbud, but not both. If entering as Cloverbud (will receive a participation ribbon only), they cannot also enter Junior Categories.
- Members entering in Junior, Intermediate and Senior Divisions may enter 2 classes with 1 entry in each class.
- Garments chosen for the contest can be new or come from your own closet or family members' closet. No newly purchased items are needed. Get creative!
- During the judging of this contest 4-H members should be aware of the cost of the garment, the fiber content, and how to care or clean the garment.

IMPRESSIVE DRESS CLASSES:

- CLASS I CASUAL WEAR Garments to wear to school, fairs, rodeos, dates, movies, spectator sports, shopping.
- CLASS II ACTIVE SPORTSWEAR Garments to wear to play tennis, skiing, jogging, etc.
- CLASS III DRESS WEAR Garments to wear to weddings, parties, church, job/college interviews.
- > CLASS IV FORMAL WEAR Garments to wear to formal events or other special occasions.
- CLASS V- WESTERN WEAR-Garments to wear to rodeo events, concerts, school, or other occasions.

Awards: The Danish system of awarding each entry a blue, red, or white award will be used. A Champion and Reserve Champion ribbon will be awarded within each class. Plaques will be awarded to the top two entries in each division.
