**Consumer Judging** – Participants make consumer decisions by comparing prices while shopping, testing qualities, and making purchases on facts and research. 3rd-12th.

**Skill-a-thons**– Animal Science, Rabbit, Poultry, Dairy, Shooting Sports, Wildlife, Land Judging, Poultry Judging, Companion Animal, Horse, FCS, Floriculture, Veterinary Science. 3rd-12th.

**Job Readiness**– Participants will "apply" for a selected job. They will complete a resume, cover letter, and an application. They must participate in an in-person interview. For Intermediates or Seniors Only.

**Archery**– Participants are allowed to participate if they have practiced the required amount of hours and are signed off by the coaches.

Tractor Driving- Participants must be signed off by county educator. 7th grade and up.

Food Showdown- Teams of 3 will prepare a dish.

**Livestock Quizbowl**– Teams of 4 will be tested on their livestock knowledge.

ATV Skills- Must be ASI Certified.

**Speech**— 1st Year 4-H Ritual, Regular talk, Illustrated presentation, individual demonstration, team demonstration, power-point, and impromptu. Demonstrations can be either food or non-food categories.

**Dutch Oven Cooking**– Teams of 2-3. Must make dish with beef and dessert with strawberries and side dish. **Cupcake Wars**– Teams of 2. Decorate the tops of three cupcakes.

Fashion and Fabrics- Participants may enter one handmade garment.

**4-H Has Talent**– Individual, small group or large group acts are allowed.

Sidewalk Chalk– Team will design chalk piece in 5x5 space.

#### Okie Showdown Swine Jackpot

The Ottawa County Fair Board is hosting the Okie Showdown Swine Jackpot at the Miami Fairgrounds on May 11-12, Mother's Day weekend. This show is part of the Eastern Kansas Swine Show Series. You must be a member in order to compete.

#### Food Contests Workshop

Participants will experience how each contest works with help from adult volunteers. They will learn to work as a team to prepare or decorate dishes and present their work. Participants will also learn how to fill out the recipe, nutrition, and teamwork sheets in the Food Showdown and Dutch Oven sections. Even if the participants don't want to compete in the 4-H contests, they will learn kitchen safety and the nutritional value of the foods they create. <u>May 28th</u> will consist of the Food Showdown and Cupcake Wars contests in the morning and the Dutch Oven Cooking in the afternoon. <u>May 29th</u> will be for individuals entering in the Oklahoma Pecan Grower's Food Show. Participants will receive help in making their entries in the food show the following Friday. Kathy Enyart will drive the entries to the show for the contestants.

#### State 4-H Round-Up

The Oklahoma State 4-H Round-Up is for 4-H'ers who have competed 7th grade and older. Round-up is a great opportunity to meet other 4-H'ers from around the state. It consists of key-note speakers, contests, workshops, fun assemblies, dances, and more. There are over 40 different workshops that fall under many project areas which you can choose from (ask for the list). Competitive events include FCS Skill-a-thon, Duds to Dazzle, ATV Safety (Certification required), Music Contest, 4-H Has Talent, Communication Contest, Tractor Driving, Natural Resources, Clover Quizbowl, Livestock Quizbowl, Fashion Revue Contest, Job Readiness, & Food Showdown. #### **TSF Nominations and OCF Entries/Tag-In**

Tulsa State Fair Nominations will be available on June 1st. The link to the Nomination website will be on the Ottawa County Extension website.

The Ottawa County Fair pre-entry will also open on June 1st. That link can also be found on the Ottawa County website. When pre-entering, please enter **ALL ANIMALS AS A PEN**. This way if there is a change in classes or exhibitor, all animals can be viewed and easily changed when checking in! If you have questions, call the office! OCF Tag-In will be June 14-15. You will receive your county tags and 840 tags here. Dairy goats, breeding goats, and breeding sheep need to have scrapie tags. All Breeding and Dairy Animals need to have birthdate available. Bring registration papers.
