TABLE SETTING: (Junior—3rd (and 8 years old)-5th (Grade our the grade you just completed)

Set the table for one person. 4-H members should plan their table setting using the following criteria:

- Choose a theme for your table setting (accessories may be used)
- Plan a menu which is suitable for the table setting. Type menu and have it available for the judge.
- Set table correctly

Have in mind any other special comments or ideas (be creative)

TABLE SETTING (Intermediate—6th – 8th grade (Grade our the grade you just completed)

Set the table for one person. 4-H members should plan their table setting using the following criteria:

- Choose a theme for your table setting (accessories may be used)
- Plan a menu which is suitable for the table setting. Type menu and have it available for the judge
- Set table correctly

Have in mind any other special comments or ideas (be creative)

TABLE SETTING (Senior—9th – 12th grade (Grade our the grade you just completed)

Set the table for one person. 4-H members should plan their table setting using the following criteria:

- Choose a theme for the dinner/table setting (accessories may be used)
- Plan a menu which is suitable for the table setting. Type menu and have it available for the judge
- Set table correctly
- Have in mind any other special comments or ideas (be creative)

For your table setting you can use one end of your dining room table or a card table (square or round)
