**ECU Homecoming Parade** 



The 4-H Royalty Contest consists of three parts:

Club Participation: 55%

Money will be raised by the contestant and club. Combine all money as much as possible. Please roll all change and cash in before turning in money. We have to write individual receipts for every check, etc. The contestant raising the most money will be given 55 points. The remaining contestants will be given a number of points equivalent to the money they raised as a percentage of the money raised by the top candidate.

#### Example:

Top candidate raises \$500 and receives 55 points;  $2^{nd}$  candidate raises \$400 and receives  $400/500 \times 55 = 44$  points;  $3^{rd}$  candidate raises \$250 and receives  $250/500 \times 55 = 27.5$  points

## Candidate Local and County Participation: 15%

In an effort to promote participation in the local club and at county activities and events, 15% of the candidates score will come from participation in the 2021-22 4-H year. Points will be determined with the above formula.

### **Individual Interview: 30%**

Interviewing is one of the most important skills a 4-H member can learn. A panel of 2 or 3 judges will question the candidate about general participation in 4-H, etc. Judges are free to ask questions of their choice.

**Escort:** 5 bonus points will be awarded to candidates who declare their escorts by the entry deadline. Educator will confirm participation of original escort nomination prior to crowning on Thursday night of the Fair. Your escort nomination and actual escort must be the same to receive the bonus points.

The results of the Royalty Contest will be announced during the fair on Thursday night.
