# I. Qualifications of County Ambassadors

- a. Applicants must be at least 11 and no older than 13 as of August 1, 2023.
- b. Must complete County Ambassador Application and upload to https:// form.jotform.com/211235908734052
- c. Interviews will be conducted on December 4, 2023 starting at 5:30p. First come, first served. No make-up interviews will be held.
- d. There will be no less than 2 Ambassadors at any time.

# II. Duties of County Ambassadors

- a. Attend teen leader meetings.
- b. Assist teen leaders in planning county events and activities.
- c. Carry a small role in the Achievement Banquet.
- d. Keep in contact with Becky to see if there is anything that needs to be done (ie programs at Cloverbuds, Teen Leaders, etc.)

### III. Application must include

- a. Application form.
- b. One page essay on "Why I think I would make a good county ambassador."
- c. Reference Sheet from one local 4-H leader and one from a non 4-H adult (ie. teacher, pastor, etc.)
- d. Certification Form with appropriate signatures
- e. Neatness of your application is a determining factor.

#### IV. Interviews will include:

- a. Interviews will be conducted by a panel of judges including Senior 4-H members, County 4-H Staff, and one outside 4-H adult. This combination can change from year to year.
- b. Dress should be professional.
  Girls: Semi-formal dresses or coordinated separates, business type suits
  Boys: Slacks and dress shirt, tie, jacket, and nice shoes.
- **V.** Remember that 1<sup>st</sup> impressions make a big difference. You want to make a good 1<sup>st</sup> impression.
