• August 13th – County Record Book Interviews

- o All members who submit a County Record Book are required to attend an interview.
- o Cloverbud Interviews are optional, not required
- Awards will be presented at the annual awards banquet in September.
- You will be recognized at banquet if:
 - You received 1st-3rd or Grand/Reserve Champion at any of the County Event Nights
 - o You submitted a County Record Book
 - You are a 2025 Graduating Senior regardless of Record Book Status. (must attend Banquet to be recognized)



County Record Books Due August 8th – Interviews August 13th

What are Record Books? They are a record of everything you have done within 4-H throughout the year (August 1st-July 31st). At the end of the 4-H Year, we have an Awards Banquet to celebrate the hard work each member has put in to their 4-H Projects. Turning in a Record Book gives you a chance at receiving awards.

After Record Books are collected, interview times will be made and sent out. Ecah member who turned in a record book is responsible for choosing their interview time and showing up at that specified time. Cloverbuds are not required to have an interview, but are welcome to do so if they wish. If you cannot attend the interviews on August 13th, please reach out.

Wagoner County Teen Leader Officer Elections – August 12th @ 6pm

- New Officers will be inducted and officially take office at the Awards Banquet in September.
- Must be present to nominate/run/vote for office
- You may have one campaign poster (not required)
- You may use PowerPoint if needed (must notify Dusti by August 5th)
- Campaign speech is only required once may run for office until you win or they run out
- Read over the by-laws so you know what the expectations are for the office you are running for.
- Offices include:
 - President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, Reporter, Recreation Leader (can be a team of 2 or an individual) please contact dusti.pardue@okstate.edu for a list of officer responsibilities
- Must be 13 or older to run for President, Vice President, or Secretary
- Must be at least 12 to run for Treasurer, Reporter, or Rec Leader(s)
- Meets every second Tuesday of the month at 6pm unless otherwise specified
- Officers must be willing and able to attend 9 of the 12 meetings per year must give a 48-hour notice if you are unable to attend a meeting. If 4 or more officers will be absent, meeting is subject to reschedule.
- Officers must attend 5 or more county wide events (event nights, fair, livestock shows, workshops, fundraisers, etc.)
