At the end of the 4-H Year, we have an Awards Banquet to celebrate the hard work each member has put in to their 4-H Projects. Turning in a Record Book gives you a chance at receiving awards. After Record Books are judged, each member, with the exception of cloverbuds, will be called in for an interview.
