

#### **LAWN & TURF**

- Mow cool-season lawns
- Continue to control broadleaf weeds in well-established warm or cool season lawn with a post emergent broadleaf weed killer

#### **FLOWERS**

- Poinsettias must have 6 hrs. of bright, indirect light, keep them away from drafts.
- Apply winter mulch to protect rose bush buds and other perennials.

### **FRUITS & NUTS**

- Cover strawberry plants with mulch about 3-4 in. thick.
- Wait to prune fruit trees until late February or March.

### LRP BASICS

LRP stands for Livestock Risk Protection. It is an insurance policy that can be purchased from insurance agents around the state. It is like crop insurance as it is a subsidized insurance product from the USDA Risk Management Agency.

It protects ONLY against falling catle prices. It is a way to establish a price floor. If prices go higher, the producer is only out the cost of the insurance. If the calculated price (see below) falls below the coverage price, a payment is originated.
