















I feed a 4-way	I ordered corn in my feed and I don't see any
Typically but not always contains: Soybean Hulls Wheat Midds	To make a consistent cube or pellet that a consumer will be happy with, the ingredients must be ground.
Corn Gluten DDGs or Corn	If you see corn in the cube, that means that they have put in some chopped corn instead of ground
What ingredients and at what inclusion rate?	Corn kernels in a cube cause a week spot in the cube and results in shorter broken cubes.
