 desired Folder → Allow to Convert file.

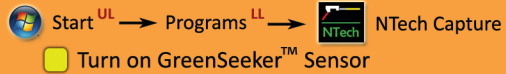


Using the IPAQ with a GreenSeeker™ Sensor

Choose Log Strips or Log Plots by clicking the titled box.

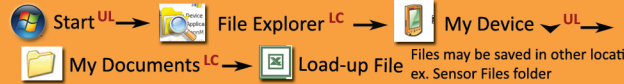
