To Use

Hold the button down (3-5 seconds) to turn the Hotspot on and off.

Click the button (3 seconds) to view information about the device, including the Wi-Fi Name and Wi-Fi Password.

Home Screen Parts



BATTERY WARNING: Over-charging battery can damage the device. To avoid this, when charging when fully charged or remove battery and plug device in.

Connect to Wi-Fi*

Go to Settings at a Time

1. Tap on Network (Wi-Fi) for Wi-Fi.
2. Click on settings on your device (might might be or).
3. Click on Wi-Fi Name (Hotspot Name) Screen & Access Control.
4. Enter the password.

*Wi-Fi ONLY

The device does not support internet connection through cables - either USB or Ethernet.

Desktop use paired with a wireless adapter. \$10 or more.

Manage Administrative Settings

1. Control for the internet with a computer, phone or tablet.
2. Type http://hotspot.sprint.com or 10.10.10.1 into a browser & press Enter.
3. Click Log In. The log in password is password.
4. From the dashboard you can manage:
 - Change Wi-Fi Name & Password
 - Allow and Deny to connect
 - Hotspot internet (allow or deny)
 - Block & Deny from connecting
