
Species Identification/Coloring Exercise Instructions

Materials:



- 1. Give students a blank beetle to color in, a picture of a *Nicrophorus* beetle and markers/colored pencils
 - a. For groups of students, hand out a variety of beetle species pictures
- Ask students to observe the colors and markings of the pictured beetle and color their blank beetle to match
- 3. When done coloring ask students if their beetle is different from their peers
- 4. Enforce that different markings indicate a different species!
- 5. Use Silphidae species poster to show different Nicrphorus species side by side
- 6. Have students identify the beetle they colored in

Quiz Instructions

- 1. Have two copies of the quiz available for each student
- 2. Give a general introduction of the American Burying Beetle
- 3. Have students answer the quiz
- 4. Conduct the coloring exercise (above)
- 5. Have students answer the quiz again they might improve some answers after learning about species during the coloring exercise
