## GUIDELINES FOR THE NORMA M. BRUMBAUGH AWARD

## **HISTORY**

The Norma M. Brumbaugh Scholarship Award was begun in 1958. At that time, members of the Oklahoma Home Demonstration Council (now Oklahoma Home and Community Education) contributed \$1,500.00 as an "offering of love" to Miss Norma M. Brumbaugh, then State Home Demonstration Agent.

The fund was presented to Miss Brumbaugh during Homemakers Conference, 1959, and was to be used for a trip to Europe. However, Miss Brumbaugh was unable to make the trip. After a great amount of thought and consideration, Miss Brumbaugh proposed that the women of the state receive the greatest benefit from the funds, since they were the original contributors. A committee of state Home Demonstration Council members was formed, and the scholarship plan was developed.

In 1961, the original fund expired. The scholarship is now funded through contributions made by County and/or local OHCE organizations to perpetuate the scholarships in Miss Brumbaugh's name.

Three (3) \$500 scholarships are paid directly by the Oklahoma Home and Community Education to qualified FCS Extension Educators who are approved by the Associate Dean, Cooperative Extension-Family and Consumer Sciences and the Oklahoma Home and Community Education Scholarship Committee Chair.

## **CRITERIA FOR SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANTS**

The state OHCE Cultural Enrichment Committee has set the following guidelines for scholarship applicants:

- 1. Scholarships must be used for professional improvement, such as credit or non-credit courses or participation in the National Extension Association of Family and Consumer Sciences' Meeting.
- 2. Recipients should remain in Extension Service work after receiving the award. If a recipient leaves Extension within two years of receiving the award, the recipient is required to refund the award in full to the Oklahoma Home and Community Education.
- 3. Each recipient must submit a poster to the chair of the Cultural Enrichment Committee by July 1 of the year following selection for the award. The poster should include pictures of the recipient. It should also explain how the award was used and what the benefits were.
- 4. An award recipient may apply for a second consecutive year. One who has received the award for two consecutive years must wait five (5) years after the second award to apply again.
