

- 1-week checkout period







Q1a. On a scale from 1-10, with 10 being high, how would you rate your satisfaction with the library hotspot program?




Q1b. On a scale from 1-10, with 10 being high, how likely are you to recommend the library hotspot program to a friend?






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
## Q2b. What is the employment status of the head of your household?




### Q2c. What is your annual household income?




## Q2d. What is the highest level of education of any adult in your household?






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
#### Q2f. How far do you drive to get to the library?






#### Q2g. How many adults live in your household?


### Q2h. How many children K-12 live with you?




## Q3a. Which of the following devices did you connect to the hotspot (choose all that apply)?




#### Q3b. Please mark your TOP 3 uses of the device







## Q3c. Please list the two websites you visited most often while checking out the device
